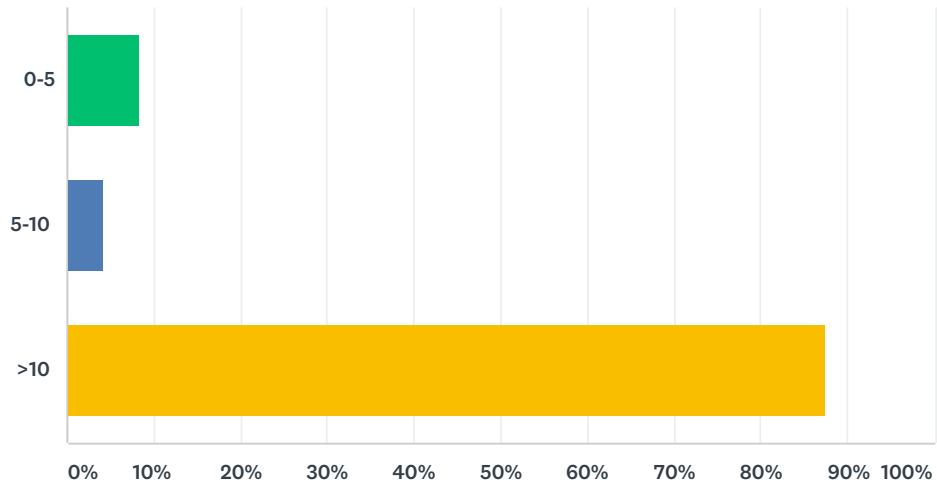

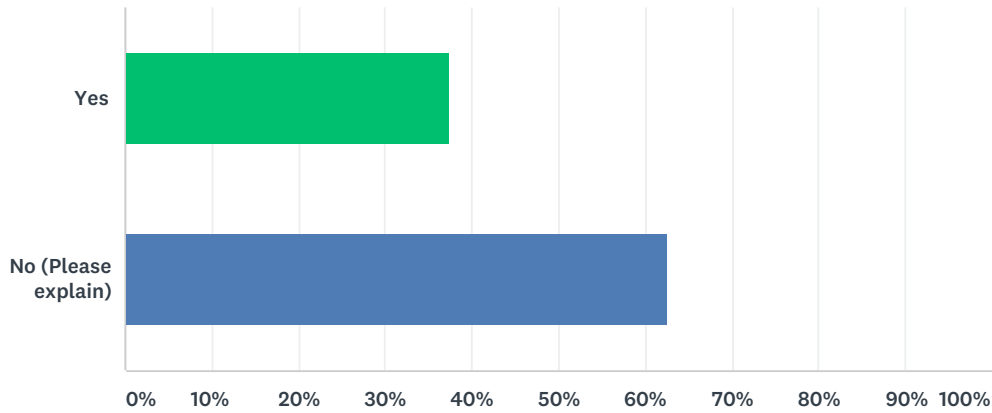

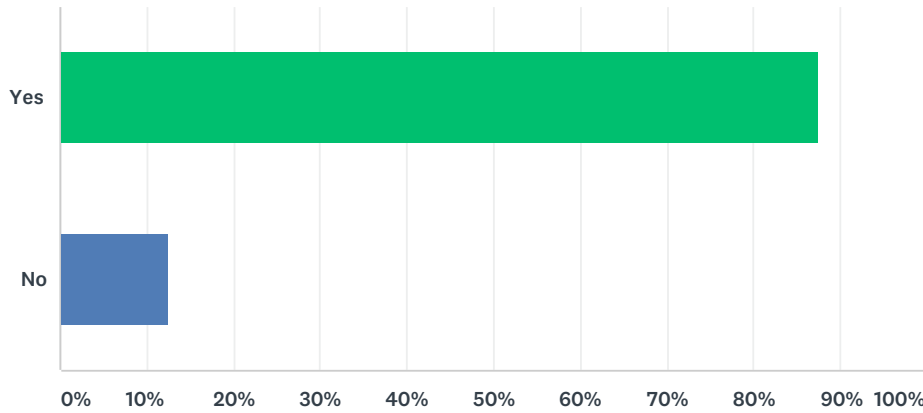

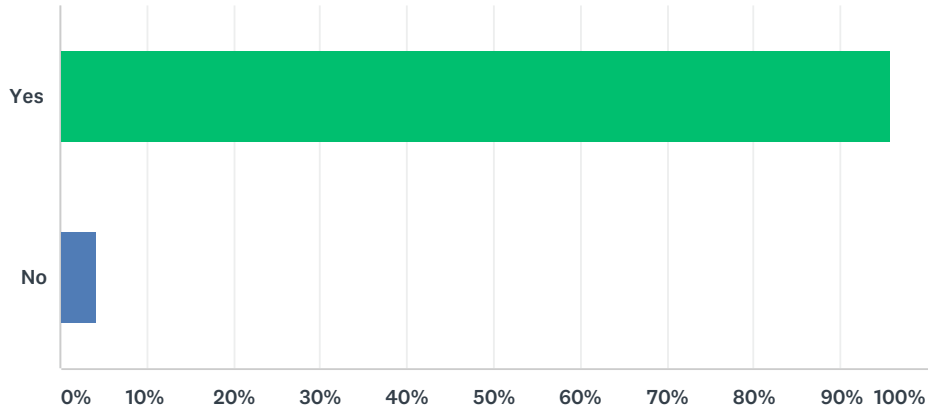

Q5 5. Did you have to come for a dinner the night before the interviews?

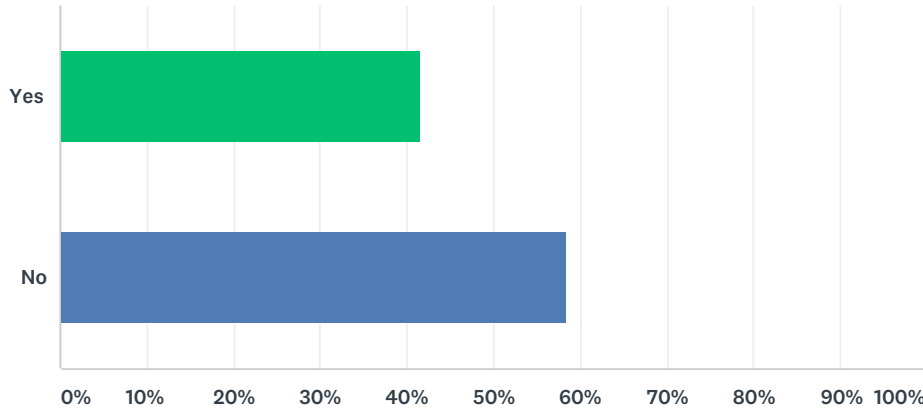

Q6 6. Did you have to stay for a dinner the night of the interview day?

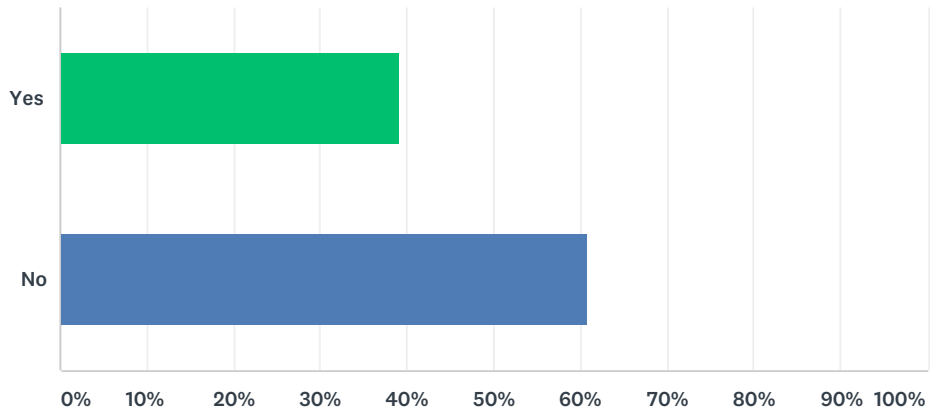

Q7 7. Would you prefer to have a group lunch on the interview day?

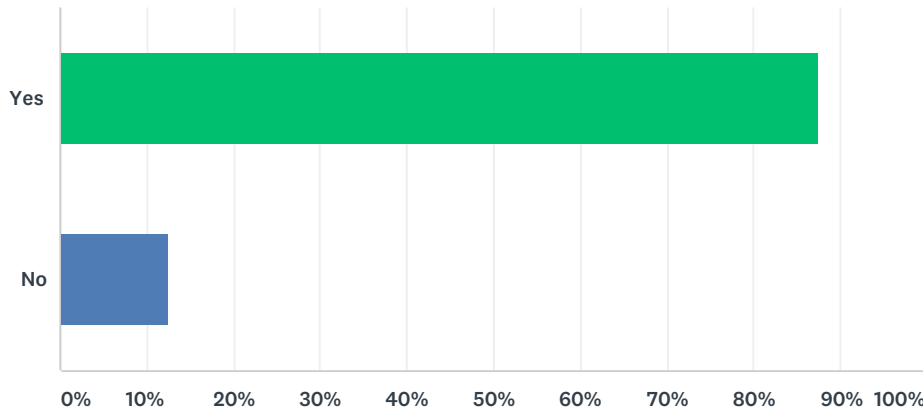

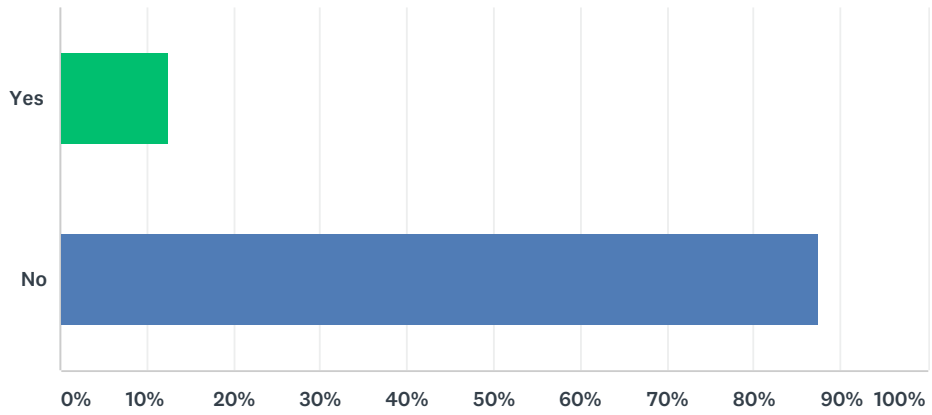

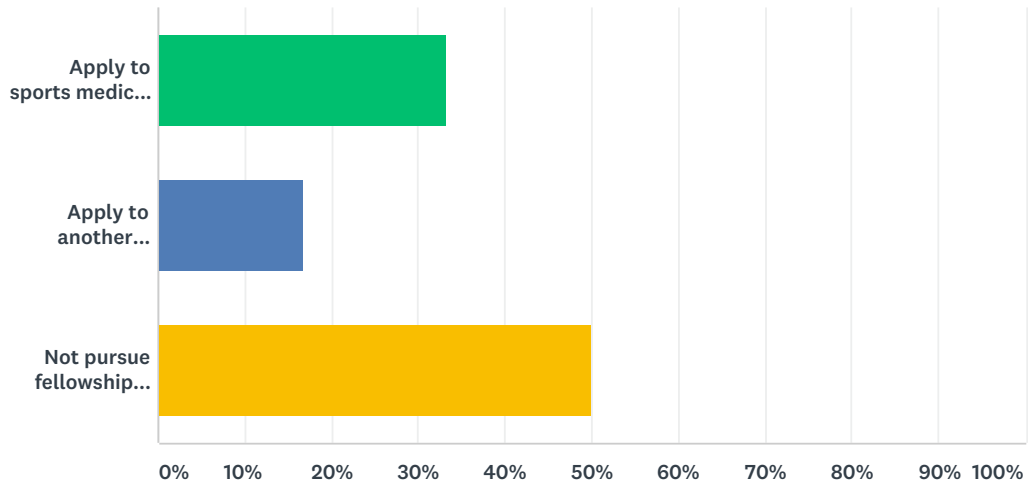

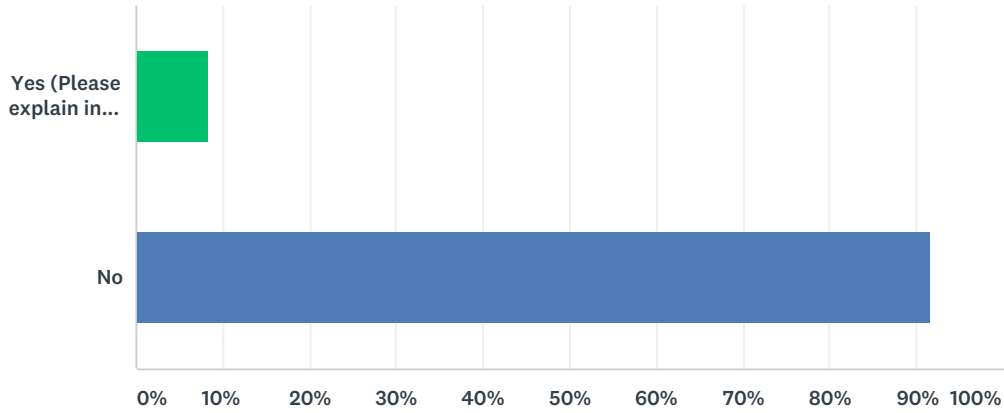

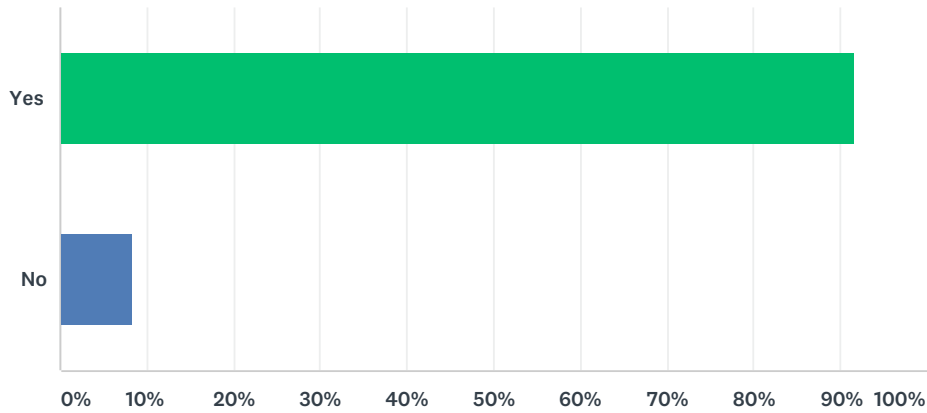
