

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



Q4 4. Would you prefer all programs to announce interview acceptances on the same date?





Q5 5. Did you have to come for a dinner the night before the interviews?





Q6 6. Did you have to stay for a dinner the night of the interview day?









I think offering applicants the option to interview in person or with Zoom as a backup option may be the best of both worlds. Encouraging coordinators to send out information at least 48hrs (ideally at least 3-4 days) in advance on when and where to show up for the interview helps with travel plans and minimizing anxiety.
