



ASES Mentorship Program Guidelines August 2018

Introduction

The American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons, in line with its objective to furnish leadership, foster advances, and enhance the study of shoulder and elbow surgery has created the ASES Mentorship program to help Candidate members advance their careers. The overall goals of this program are to promote education, practice management, academic advancement, research, society interaction and advancement within ASES.

Program Guidelines

1. The ASES Mentorship Program will last one (1) year.
2. In general, mentors should only have one mentee at a time. Two mentees may be acceptable if approved by the mentor and the Mentorship Sub-committee.
3. Mentors and mentees should meet in person at the ASES Annual Meeting and/or the AAOS Annual Meeting/Specialty Day.
4. It is recommended that there is at least one site visit to the mentor's practice.
5. Mentors and mentees should keep in touch by phone/web conference every 6-8 weeks to discuss topics of interest.
6. At the end of the 12 -months period mentors and mentees will receive an evaluation to rate the program.
